

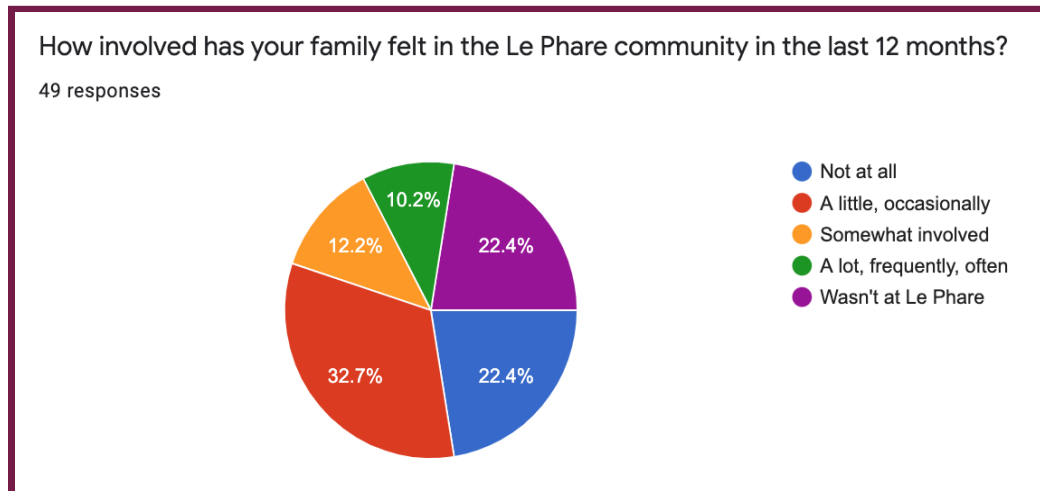
Le Phare Family Survey Findings - September 2021

School Council received **49 responses** to our survey
(of ~350 students, that's great, given that many families have more than one kid!)

51% are excited to return to school in person!

Another 41% are optimistic but cautious. Only 6 % felt uneasy/nervous.

The majority felt involvement with the Le Phare community was lacking.
Council will try, although we're still in a pandemic phase. We will count on you!



Almost 80% would like to attend **in-person events** to get involved in the community.

More than 50% are willing to answer surveys/forms.

Most families have a great experience at Le Phare!

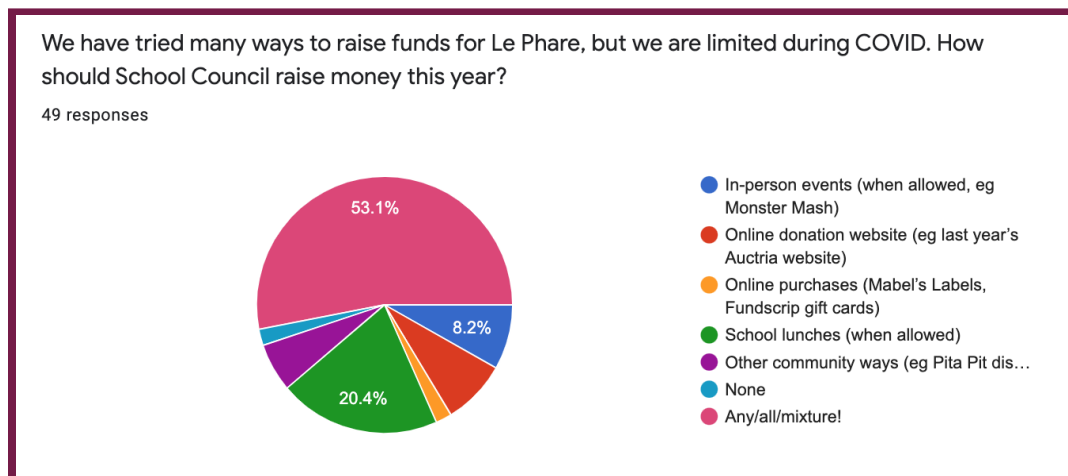
We see excellence in proximity/transportation

Your highest priorities for Council spending are: literacy, math/STEM, French and outdoor play.

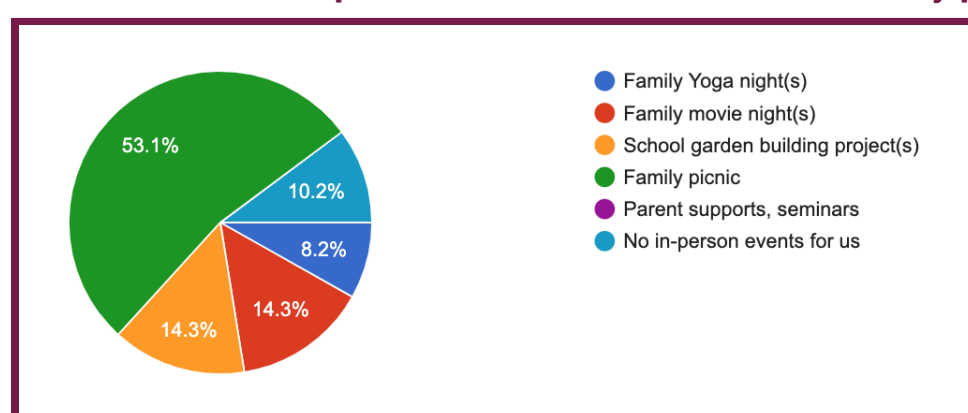
Barriers to joining Council are for sure a lack of time or energy (80%). We hear that.
