Principals' update and Q&A

- Scientists in schools scheduled for this month, Gr 4 and Gr 5. Thanks to Council donation.
- Reintroducing school assemblies since Covid. Starts this Friday.
- Booked Inuit Centre presentation in February for the whole school "Games in the Igloo", and it's free!
- Exploring ideas for outdoor education activity to use with a grant that's available to the school budget (not a Council-led Grant application)
- On field trips, finding buses is hard for more than one class at a time (cost notwithstanding, buses are overbooked). But School willing to pursue off-site field trips.
- School leadership team re-opened for students. Sub committees assemblies, winter play day, art displays, etc. Discussion about the possibility of a Gr. 5-led fundraiser.
