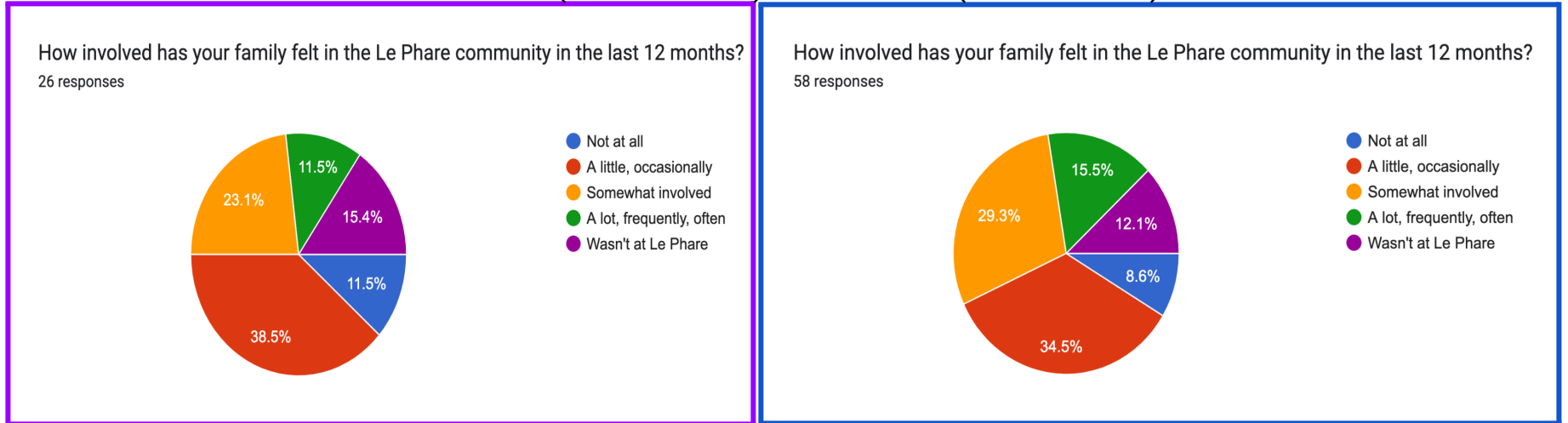


Le Phare Family Survey Findings - November 2023

School Council received **58 responses** to our survey.
Wow! **95%** are Great/Excited/Thriving and Decent/Optimistic/Adjusting at school this year.

A sense of community involvement continues to improve.

Oct 2022 (**34% involved**) vs Nov 2023 (**45% involved**)



HOW DO YOU WANT TO GET INVOLVED?

84% want to attend in-person events. **61%** like to receive emails and answer surveys. **45%** prefer to donate money.

Most families have a great experience at Le Phare

We see excellence in **proximity/transportation** to the school, **equity and inclusion**, **Communication with teachers**, and **French immersion**.

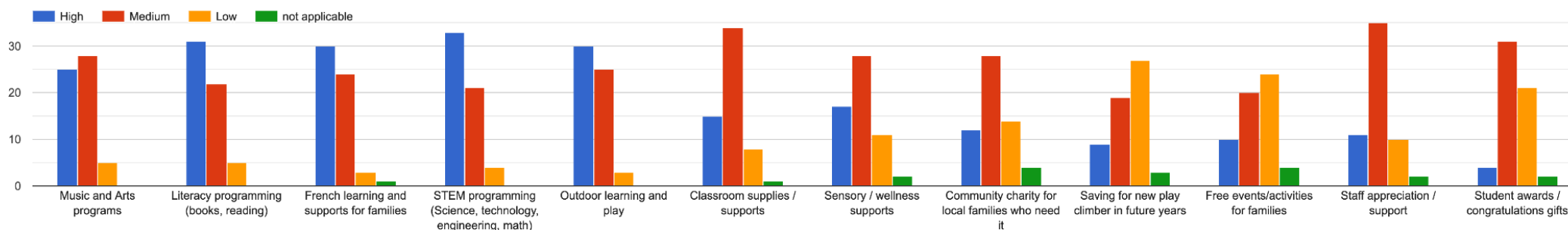
Areas for improvement are: **bullying, special needs**, the **yard**, and the **school facilities**. We see a decrease in **communication with Principals**.

You're most likely to volunteer during family events (49%).

However, many **prefer to donate money rather than time (33%)**, or maybe volunteer **another year (32%)**.

Your priorities for Council spending are: Music/Arts, Literacy, STEM, French, and Outdoor Learning.

Not priorities: Saving for a new play climber; Free events; Student awards/gifts.



A barrier to joining Council remains a **lack of time/energy, at 56%**, similar last year.

Maintain academic rigour. Keep the yard interesting.	Extra support for French immersion language learning to make up for lost time during the pandemic
Field trips, especially for the grade 5s. Some how my children are in classes that have had no field trips since precovid. But others have had them. I'm not sure how some classes get field trips and others don't.	The arts is severely lacking at Le Phare so I would like to see more programming related to that. I also would really like to see classes go on more field trips (museums, city hall, art gallery etc)
Principal is be hired for consistency and leadership	Let's keep the kids active - it would be great to invest in the older kids playground or more gym time daily for the kids
Community charity for local families who need it and pizza lunches for kids in need	Stable principal; VP stays!
Children's activities and sports including early math and skills that would help develop children better	I really like receiving emails and being in the loop with what is happening at the school. This helps me better help my children.
The school lacks resources to effectively manage behaviours and attend to children's mental health	Equity and inclusion
Stable school environment. Our kids are resilient but if we can have a permanent long standing engaging and open Principal, I believe that would help in students to have a sense of belonging. So many changes in past 2 years is difficult on kids as well as parents.	Music and Arts (in school events, visitors, outside hours famiky events, trios)
Consistent leadership - consistent teachers	Focus on inclusion and maintaining free events with donations optional
