
School Council received 26 responses to our survey (down from 49 the previous year)

65% were excited to return to school in person! (up from 51% last year) Another **35%** were optimistic but cautious. About **7%** felt uneasy/nervous.




A full 100% wanted to attend in-person events to get involved in the community! Yay!

Most families have a great experience at Le Phare!

We saw excellence in **proximity/transportation** to the school and in **equity and inclusion**, like last year. **Communication with teachers** saw a big improvement since last year!

The greatest areas for improvement were: help with bullying and health and safety/COVID (differing from last year, when communication was a bigger concern)

Many families wanted to attend events, especially the Monster Mash and the Spring Picnic. These events build community, and raise funding.



Your priorities for Council spending remain: literacy, math/STEM, French, outdoor learning. Staff appreciation and music/arts were higher this year than last year.

One barrier to joining Council remained a **lack of time/energy**, but this was **down to 55% from 80%** the previous year.

About **45%** wanted to provide input through forms and surveys. And **30%** just wanted to learn more.
